## FISTUALAGRAM/ ANGIOPLASTY/ THROMBECTOMY POST PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

Dressing: Remove dressing in 24 hours

Bleeding: Apply only gentle pressure with 2 fingers on top of the dressing until it stops. Do not remove the dressing

Diet: Resume previous diet.

Activity: Do not lift anything or strain your access arm for 24 Hours

**Medications:** 

No change to medications. Resume previous medications.

Anesthesia: You were given moderate sedation. This type of medication can make you sleepy; for the next 24 hours DO NOT drive a car, run machinery or power tools. DO NOT drink alcohol. DO NOT make important decisions or sign important papers.

Please call the office at (562)888-8961 for:

Bleeding does not stop after applying light pressure for 15-30 minutes.

Fever over 101 degrees or chills

Pain NOT relieved with Tylenol (you may be sore for 1 to 2 days and this is normal)

Redness, swelling, or drainage coming from the access site

Numbness, tingling or swelling of the arm, hand or leg that has the fistula or graft

For emergencies call 911.
